

GENERAL INFORMATION

The **Moose Jaw Business Excellence (MJBEX) Awards** are open to all businesses, except Crown Corporations and the City of Moose Jaw. To be eligible for a category, the registrant must not have won a MJBEX Award in that category in the previous year. Registrants may submit their own registrations or third parties may submit the registration. The registrant must agree to all third party registrations.

The business may submit a registration in up to two categories from the following **MJBEX Award** categories:

- Community Involvement
- Customer Service
- Young Entrepreneur
- Business of the Year
- Marketing
- Healthy Work Place
- New Business Venture
- Job Creation
- Pioneer Award
- Business Innovation
- Business Leader of the Year

Once you have decided which category or categories the business is to be registered for:

STEP 1: Complete the general registration form on Page 3

STEP 2: Complete the registration form(s) corresponding to the category or categories you have chosen to enter. **There are separate registration forms for each category.** Please note that each registrant is limited to maximum of two categories.

STEP 3: Return the completed forms before noon on January 27, 2012 to:

STEP 4: All registrations will be reviewed by the MJBEX Awards Selection Committee, to decide on maximum three finalists for each category.

STEP 5: The MJBEX Awards Selection Committee will forward the names of the finalists to an anonymous MJBEX Awards Jury for selection of winners.

Any information you provide will remain confidential. All information after judging will be returned to you.

The MJBEX Award Categories and Criteria

The **MJBEX Award program** consists of seven awards as follows:

1. Community Involvement

To be awarded to the business that demonstrates exceptional performance in its support of recreation, amateur sports, arts and culture, charitable or non-profit volunteer groups. Judging will take into account relative size of business.

2. Customer Service

To be awarded to the business that consistently demonstrates excellence in service and/or hospitality. Criteria will examine services offered by the business; training programs for staff and management or its contribution to the Moose Jaw and immediate area tourism. Judging will take into account relative size of business.

3. Young Entrepreneur

Awarded to a young entrepreneur (age 35 or under on December 31, 2011) who has established or expanded a business on or before January 1, 2011. The young entrepreneur will have demonstrated signs of success and viability in the venture. Judging will take into account relative size of business.

4. Business of the Year

Open to all businesses that have been operating for at least three years as of December 31, 2011. To be awarded to a business that demonstrates overall success, judged according to certain financial criteria, growth, use of capital investment, exceptional performance in exporting goods, job creation, stability or community involvement.

5. Marketing

This award is to the business demonstrating exceptional performance in marketing; which has had a positive effect on sales and product recognition. The jury evaluates the success of a marketing program giving consideration to the nature of the product and the relative size of the business.

1. Healthy Workplace

This award is designed to recognize businesses that are creating a healthy workplace environment.

2. New Business Venture

To be awarded to a new business that has been operating for less than two years, as of December 31, 2011 and which has demonstrated positive performance in terms of certain financial criteria, expansion into new product line or business, creation of new markets or job creation. Judging will take into account relative size of the business.

3. Job Creation

To be awarded to the business demonstrating exceptional performance in creating new permanent jobs. The jury evaluates the growth and creation of new jobs taking into account the relative size and nature of the business.

4. Pioneer Award

This award is designed to recognize pioneer and cornerstone business leaders in Moose Jaw & District who have demonstrated excellence over an extended period of time and whose business has contributed to the economic well-being of Moose Jaw and district. The business must have been in continuous operation for at least fifteen (15) years.

5. Business Innovation

This award is designed to recognize innovation success by a business which adapts to market place challenges resulting in a competitive advantage.

8. Business Leader of the Year

The Achievement for Business Excellence Award for Business Leader of the Year is awarded to an individual who exemplifies the qualities of the business visionary. This person has shown outstanding success in business or industry through the development of a new process, product or service or for meaningful contributions to the local business community.

You may provide examples of recognition from other sources)

5. Number of years in business (minimum 15 years) (1 – 20 points)
